Diocesan Open Air

Both Bishop's of Clogher organise an open-air ecumenical service on Pentecost each year. This year the service is on the 31st May at 3.30pm in the Old Graveyard at Errigal Truagh. This is a mile or so off the Monaghan Aughnacloy road just on the southern side of the border and is sign posted from the main road. Everyone is welcome.

Each year the Monaghan Youth Council run a series of events one of which is a sponsored walk on St. Patrick's Day. The money collected is handed over at an annual Praise service which we are hosting this year. It will be held on Sunday 7th June at 7.30pm
